The scholarships listed below are the scholarships which are available through the Lebanon Educational Foundation as of December 2022. This list is subject to change. Scholarships may be added or removed from the list based on fund availability and market fluctuations. STUDENTS SHOULD CHECK THE LEF WEBSITE OR CONFIRM SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABILITY WITH THE LHS GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO COMPLETING THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION.

All selections of scholarships recipients will be made by the Lebanon Educational Foundation Scholarship Committee.

Alice Richardson Memorial English Scholarship \$1500

The recipient of this scholarship must have a 3.0 GPA and plan to major in Secondary English Education. The recipient must attend a four-year college or university, in or out of state. The scholarship may be used for tuition, room and board, books or fees.

Bob Hawkins Memorial Law Enforcement Scholarship \$1000.00

The family and friends of Bob Hawkins have established this scholarship for a student that has a GPA of 2.5 or higher and who is entering the field of law enforcement or criminal justice or the child of a member of the law enforcement. May attend a two or four year, public or private college or university.

Boone County Realtors \$1000.00

The Boone County Realtors have established a scholarship for a student who has been accepted into a technical or trade school, in-state or out-of-state. The recipient must have maintained a C average or above during all four years of high school. No specific area of study is required.

Bob J. Ross Scholarship \$1500

A scholarship has been established for a senior who plans to major in Education, School Counseling or Educational Administration. The recipient must plan to attend Indian State University, Ball State University, or Indiana University. The recipient must have a 3.75 GPA or higher and be in the top 20% of their class.

Carol Belles Music Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be an LHS senior student who has participated in a minimum of three years of choir and/or band during high school and plans to attend a four-year college or university. Selection preference will be given to any applicant(s) who plans to major in performing arts, music, drama, or band.

Cheryl Ann Cowan Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

Recipient must be accepted and plan to attend a state-supported university, majoring in Elementary Education and must be in the top 20% of the graduating class.

Cody Jedwabny Memorial Golf Scholarship \$1000 (2)

The recipient must have participated in the LHS golf program for at least one year and have a 2.5 GPA or higher. The recipient must have been accepted into a trade or vocational school, a two- or four-year college or university in-state.

Denger Family Scholarship \$8,000.00

Recipient must plan to attend at least a four year or more college or university degree program, full-time. No specific field of study is required. A "B" average or better during high school is required to qualify for the scholarship

Edward Jones Scholarship \$1500.00

The recipient must be a graduating senior of Lebanon High School and plan to attend a four-year college or university after graduation. The recipient must have a minimum weighted GPA of 3.5 or higher. The applicant can plan to study any major or field of study.

Else Ten Eyck Trimble Scholarship \$1000.00

The recipient must be accepted into a one, two, three- or four-year program. The recipient must have attended LHS for four years and be in the top 50% of the senior class.

FFA Alumni Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be an LHS senior student who has been an active participant in FFA for a minimum of three years. The recipient must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. The student must complete the FFA Student Involvement form, which can be obtained by the FFA President or teacher advisor. The FFA Student Involvement form must be attached to the LEF Scholarship Application. No specific area of study is required.

James Rosenstihl Memorial Basketball Scholarship \$2500.00 (2)

The recipient must be an LHS senior who is a team member on the LHS boys or girls' basketball team and who has been accepted into a public or private, in-state or out-of-state college or university. No specific area of study is required.

Jay Anderson Memorial Swimming Scholarship (2) \$500.00

The Recipients of this scholarship must have been a member of the LHS swimming team, exhibited outstanding sportsmanship during the season and completed the season.

Joan A. Hayes Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The family of Joan A. Hayes has established a scholarship in her memory for a student with a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to attend Purdue University and major in science or education.

John Isenhower Memorial Scholarship \$500.00 (2)

Recipient must be a graduating senior and must have played a minimum of one LHS sport for at least two years during high school. The recipient may attend a university or technical school after graduation. The recipient should possess strong leadership skills and a positive mental attitude. A male and female will be awarded the scholarship.

Jones/Hays Jones Scholarship 10000.00

The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and be accepted into any of the following forms of post-secondary education: vocational, trade school, two/four-year college, public/private and must be in the state of Indiana. Applicant must submit an essay, "Why is giving back to your community important?"

Judy Cunningham - "Yes, You Can Do It" Scholarship (\$2500.00)

The recipient must have a 3.0 GPA or higher and plan to attend a vocational or trade school, two- or four-year college or university, in-state, public or private.

Lebanon Tennis Scholarship \$500.00 (2)

The recipient must be LHS Senior tennis players who have been a member of the boys Tennis team playing at the varsity level and a member of the girls Tennis team playing at the varsity level for at least two years and received a letter in or by their senior year. The student must have been accepted into a trade, vocational, two-year, or four-year college or university public or private, in state or out-of-state. The recipient must have a 3.0 or higher GPA. No specific area of study is required, and the student does not have to continue their tennis career at the collegiate level.

LEF Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be an LHS graduating senior who has been accepted into an accredited two- or four-year college or university or a two- or four-year technical school. No specific area of study is required.

LHS Soccer Golden Goal Scholarship \$500.00 (2)

This scholarship will be awarded to a boy and girl who have been accepted into a trade, vocational, two- or four-year college or university. The recipient must have a 2.5 or higher GPA and have participated in at least two years of varsity soccer and have been in good standing in the athletic department.

Lucas E. Keesee Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be an LHS graduating senior who has been accepted into an accredited two- or four-year college or university or a two- or four-year technical school. The recipient must have a GPA of 2.0 or higher. The student must participate in a sport offered by LHS during their senior year. The student must participate in an organization/activity offered by LHS during their senior year. No specific area of study is required.

LT Rich Products Vocational Scholarship \$500.00

The recipient must be accepted into a trade or vocational school and have a 2.5 or higher GPA. The student must plan to study, but not limited to, welding, heating and air, plumbing, construction or building trades.

Marilyn Suzanne Kern Memorial Scholarship \$500

Recipient has been accepted and will attend Purdue University, achieved a "B" average or better and has participated in extra-curricular activities. No specific area of study is required.

K.C. Kays Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00

Recipient must attend either a university or technical school to study aviation. The Lebanon Educational Foundation's standard scholarship application must be completed, and the applicant must complete a 1,000-word essay on the subject: "The Sacrifices Necessary to Keep America Free."

Katie A. Brown Memorial Scholarship \$2500.00

The scholarship will be awarded to a female student that has been accepted into a four-year college or university and plans to study a science related field. The recipient must have attended LHS for four years and been active in the community and participated in one athletic program each of the four years. The recipient must have a 3.5 GPA.

Keith Norton Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The recipient of this scholarship must plan to attend a four-year college or university and major in engineering. The recipient must be in the top 25% of the senior class.

Kenneth Recher Memorial Basketball Scholarship \$1000.00. The recipient must have had a strong academic performance and had a positive contribution to the basketball program at Lebanon High School. The recipient must be accepted to a one, two, three- or four-year college university or technical school.

Kiwanis Club of Lebanon Technical Scholarship \$500.00

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS graduating senior who will be attending a technical or trade program or school after graduation. The recipient must exemplify good citizenship and service to the community and/or school.

Kiwanis Club of Lebanon Scholarship \$750.00 (2)

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS senior graduate who will be attending a two-year or four-year college or university. The recipient must exemplify good citizenship and service to the community and/or school.

Luther M. Hayes Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The family of Luther M. Hays have established a scholarship for an LHS senior who will be attending Purdue University and majoring in engineering with preference given to aeronautical engineering.

Max Foster Memorial Scholarship \$500.00

This scholarship will be awarded to a senior who plans to attend a vocational school, a trade school or an apprenticeship. The recipient must have a 2.0 GPA. The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies or tools. The school may be an in state or out of state school.

Obremskey Family Scholarship \$10,000.00

Recipient must have been accepted and will attend Indiana University (any campus), excel in leadership and extracurricular activities and is in the top 20% of the graduating class.

Opal Galvin Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The recipient must plan to major in business and may attend any four-year college or university.

Paul and Mary Taylor Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The recipient Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and plan to attend an in-state school, two or four-year school. The scholarship may be used for tuition, room and board or books and supplies.

Pliny and Mildred Randall \$8000.00 (3)

The recipient must plan to attend a four-year or more college or university program, full-time. Recipients must rank in the top one-third of their graduating class. The winner will be announced during the LHS Awards Night in May.

Ralph Wortman Scholarship \$250.00

The recipient must be an LHS senior n-state school student who has been accepted into a trade, vocational, two year or four-year college or university public or private. The recipient needs to be a past member of the Lebanon Area Boys and Girls Club and provide documentation with the application that they have volunteered at the Lebanon Area Boys and Girls Club. A separate essay on the impact the club has had on the students is also required.

Rebecca DeLaRosa Memorial Scholarship \$2000.00

The recipient of the scholarship must plan to attend a trade, vocation, two- or four-year college or university, public or private, in state or out of state. The recipient must be of Hispanic/Latino descent and be the first generation of the family to attend post-secondary education. The recipient must have a 2.5 GPS or higher.

Richard and Donna Linton Memorial Scholarship \$1,000.00

Recipient must plan to attend a four-year Indiana college or university and must be studying business. A "B" average or better is required. The recipient must have a strong desire to become a business owner or an entrepreneur in the future.

Ron Ebert Baseball Scholarship \$1500

The recipient must be accepted to a two- or four-year college or university, a trade or vocational school, in state or out of state school. The recipient must have exhibited a positive attitude both during practice and during the game. The recipient does not have to play baseball in college. The recipient must have played baseball for four years at the high school level.

Ron Lind Memorial Scholarship \$2000.00 The scholarship will be awarded to a senior who will attend any Indiana University Campus, plan to study business. The student must have a B or C average.

Ruth Butcher Saxton Scholarship \$500.00

Recipient must be accepted to a one, two, three- or four-year field of study. The recipient must major in journalism/publications, telecommunications or a journalism related field.

Ruth E. Brookshire Memorial Scholarship approximately \$15,000

The recipient must plan to attend Ivy Tech or a vocational or trade school in Indiana for two years. The student must have a GPS of 2.5 or higher.

Sam Herr Memorial Agricultural Scholarship \$500.00

Recipient must be an LHS senior student who has been accepted into a college or university, public or private, in-state or out-of-state and must plan to study agriculture. The recipient must be in good academic standing and must have maintained a minimum of a "C" average during high school.

Shelby Jones Memorial Scholarship \$1000.00

The family of Shelby Jones has established a scholarship in his memory. The recipient must plan to major in agriculture or horticulture and may attend an in-state or out-of-state school.

State Bank Scholarship \$1000.00

Recipient must plan to attend a four-year college or university in Indiana and major in business. Based on academic performance as determined by the Foundation.

Tiger Merit Scholarship \$1000.00

This scholarship is awarded to an LHS Senior who exemplifies good citizenship, school service and academic excellence.

VFW Post #910 Men's Auxiliary Scholarship \$500.00

Recipient must be accepted to a two- or four-year college or university and have a GPA of 3.0. Candidates must submit an essay entitled "What Does Patriotism Mean to Me?". Consideration will be given to children or grandchildren of veterans.
